Enjoy the old restored homes and commercial buildings as you drive through the town. Please drive slow and yield to the pedestrians. (You have been given a map of city's historic buildings.)

- Left onto Alexander.
- Right onto Front.
- Right onto Gould
- Right onto 9<sup>th</sup>.
- Left onto Center
- Right onto 8th.
- Left onto Main

- Go straight at intersection. - - which crosses Hwy 20. Use caution.

- Right at stop sign (which is Engle Road).
- Right at Fort Casey Historical Park-The road goes up the hill.

Our ending point is the picnic area that you pass on your right, but before you go there, go on to the Fort and answer a few more questions. Be careful—watch out for the "big guns."
