2002 FEN Kitsap Tour and Picnic

This route starts at the Albertson Grocery at the corner of SR 104, Miller Bay Rd (to the south) and Hansville Rd (to the north) approximately 1.5 miles west of Kingston.

Exit the parking lot at the south end and turn right onto SR104, continue straight through the traffic light.

Turn right at the next traffic light and continue west on SR104.

Follow SR 104 into the historic village of Port Gamble. There is a museum in town on the right.

SR104 makes a sharp left in the village and continues to the west.

Go straight at traffic light! - SR 104 veers to the right & crosses Hood Canal - Now on SR 3 southbound.

Turn left onto Big Valley Road. Follow Big Valley Rd until the stop sign at the intersection with Bond Road.

Cross Bond Rd. You're now on Little Valley Rd – use caution this is a very narrow twisting road, there are speed bumps up ahead.

At the end of Little Valley Rd, across Forest Rock Lane is Central Market, if you need picnic supplies, definitely go here.

Turn right onto Forest Rock Lane and at the next traffic light, turn left onto SR 305.

At the 3rd traffic light, turn right onto Hostmark St.

Go down the hill and the road turns to the right to become Front Street.

Follow Front St through Poulsbo and enjoy the sights.

At the 4 way stop sign, go straight and then slightly to your left and up the hill to stay on Front Street.

At the traffic light the road becomes Lindvig Way, continue through the light.

Turn left at the next traffic light onto Viking Ave.

Follow Viking Ave (it becomes Silverdale Way).

Turn right onto Mountain View Rd.

Turn left onto Clear Creek Rd. at the stop sign.

Turn right onto Halfmile Rd.

Turn left onto Old Frontier Rd at stop sign. Continue through the traffic light. Continue through the next traffic light and cross Anderson Hill Rd. The road becomes Provost Rd.

At the stop sign turn right onto Newberry Ell Rd and follow it up and down hills. It eventually T's into Seabeck Highway.

Turn right onto Seabeck Hwy Follow Seabeck Hwy into the village of Seabeck. Slow down and don't blink.

After passing through Seabeck, turn right on to Miami Beach Road.

Shortly, Miami Beach Rd veers off to the fight -just stay on the main road, now Scenic Beach Rd, keep going and you will come to the entrance to Scenic Beach State Park.

After entering the park, continue down the hill, look for parking off to the left. Back among the trees are a large grassy area, tables, etc, and beach access.

Leave the park via the same street you entered (the only way into and out of the park).

Follow Scenic Beach Rd back to Miami Beach Rd and then back to Seabeck Hwy.

Turn right on to Seabeck Hwy, which, to the right, is now Seabeck-Holly Rd.

Turn left onto Holly Rd. Holly Rd will wind about the countryside and intersect Seabeck Hwy.

Turn right onto Seabeck Hwy.

Follow Seabeck Hwy until it merges with Northlake Way.

Turn right onto West Kitsap Lake Drive. The street sign is somewhat hidden on the left.

West Kitsap Lake Drive will skirt the west side of Kitsap Lake and make a sharp 90 to become Price Road.

Turn right onto Harlow Drive.

Turn right onto Auto Center Blvd. Check out the new and used cars on either side of the street.

At the traffic light at Werner Road, continue straight, the road becomes Union Ave.

Turn right onto 3d Ave.

Turn right onto W Harbor Dr it makes a sharp left and becomes Kent Ave.

Turn right onto Sherman Heights Rd.

Stop at the railroad track and then go down the hill and stop again - use caution at this three-way stop.

Turn right onto Old Belfair Valley Rd. You are now in Gorst - named for an aviation pioneer.

Turn left onto Sam Christopherson Ave.

Continue through the traffic light, crossing SR3. You are now on a frontage road and will shortly merge onto SRI 6 eastbound.

ASAP, move to the left lane to take a left lane exit.

Exit SR 16 and head for Port Orchard on SR I 66-Bay Street.

Follow SR166 along Sinclair Inlet. Puget Sound Naval Shipyard will appear across the water.

Continue through downtown Port Orchard and watch for the FORD dealer on the left, you will soon turn left.

Turn left at the traffic light with a KFC on the right.

You are still on Bay Street. Go along the water and suddenly there is a 90 to the right-use care as there is no shoulder and some times pedestrians.

Continue on Bay Street, but it soon changes to Beach Drive E. Follow Beach Drive as it winds along the water - watch for wildlife and ferries. Eventually you leave the water's edge when the road makes a sharp turn to the right. Your are still on Beach Drive. It continues to wind through the countryside and eventually meets Main St, in the village of Manchester.

Turn left at the stop sign - go a very short block and turn right onto Colchester Drive E. Here is a nice view of Seattle and Blake Island.

Follow Colchester Drive up the hill.

Turn left onto Yukon Harbor Drive, a gazebo is on the fight. Watch for speed bumps up ahead. Again, good views to the left. Yukon Harbor Dr. meets Southworth Drive at a stop sign.

Turn left onto Southworth Drive, continuing along the water. If you notice a strong odor it is the seaweed at low tide. Use caution at the sharp right turn marked for 15 NWH.

Turn left onto Olympiad Drive.

Turn left at the stop sign at Olympiad/Nokomis 'T' intersection, the road then makes a sharp right.

Follow this road as it winds around and makes a sharp left to become Cherry Street. It makes a few more turns and stops at the intersection with Southworth Dr.

Turn left, go a very short distance and stop again, then go down the hill to the ferry terminal and back to Seattle.
